Michigan CASA operates <http://www.michigancasa.org> (the "Site"). This page informs you of our policies regarding the collection, use and disclosure of Personal Information we receive from users of the Site.

We use your Personal Information only for providing and improving the Site. By using the Site, you agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this policy.

Information Collection, Use, and Online Donations

We do not collect personally identifiable information ("Personal Information") directly from our Site.

We collect online donations through PayPal unless otherwise clearly noted on the Site (for example, during a promotional donation event). Your Personal Information is collected on PayPal or any other donation website we use. Please refer to the respective websites for information regarding their use of your Personal Information.

Personal Information gathered when an online donation is made may be relayed back to us. This can include, but is not limited to, name, home address, email address, phone number, payment amount, type of payment, and any messages the donor attaches to their donation. We use this information to update our donation records, which are stored on our secured databases. We do NOT share this information with the general public or any entity outside of Michigan CASA.

Log Data

Like many site operators, we collect information that your browser sends whenever you visit our Site ("Log Data").

This Log Data may include information such as your computer's Internet Protocol ("IP") address,

browser type, browser version, the pages of our Site that you visit, the time and date of your visit, and the time spent on those pages and other statistics.

Communications

We may use your Personal Information to contact you. We send out thank you letters to donors as a tax receipt and to show our gratitude. Once a year we send out a letter to all previous donors on record to ask for another single donation or a pledge.

Security

The security of your Personal Information is important to us, but remember that no method of transmission over the Internet, or method of electronic storage, is 100% secure. While we strive to use commercially acceptable means to protect your Personal Information, we cannot guarantee its absolute security.
